

## ROADLESS AREAS TASK FORCE PUBLIC COMMENT MEETINGS

### Ground Rules

#### RESPECT

- Use the time allotted, do not take the time of others
- Listen with an open mind
- No interruptions, verbal, or visual
- Do not repeat previous points
- Refrain from applause
- Speak for your view only, not against others

#### WHEN SPEAKING

- State your name & organization (if any)
- Be as specific, on the ground detail oriented as possible-WHAT are your concerns; WHERE are they located on the ground
- Substance over opinion
- Use respectful language (no cursing, name calling etc.)

### Public Meeting Format (3 hrs 30 min)

- I. Opening & Introduction to the Process – Keystone
  - Agenda/process Review (process at the meeting) – 3 panels and open microphone
  - Ground Rules for speakers and audience
- II. Task Force Welcome -Chair
  - Welcome
  - Task Force purpose/charge & members introduction
  - How comments will be integrated, weighted
- III. Panel 1 – Forest Service-Template Presentation (15 min presentation, 15 min Q&A) *Forest Service presentations will address TF questions sent in advance*
- IV. Panel 2 – State and local government – county commissioners, local government officials and Department of Natural Resources agencies (30 min presentations, 30 min Q&A)
- V. Panel 3 – Stakeholder groups: environmental, timber, motorized recreation, energy, etc. (45 min, 15 min Q&A). Speakers will be selected by TF to present a broad range of perspectives
- VI. Open Microphone (50 minutes); Chair will select a representative sample of speakers to reflect the range of perspectives in the room, with the time allowed
  - One minute per speaker
  - Sign-up with Speaker Sign-up form; it is important to indicate the topics the speaker will address on the form
